

CIDOC Train The Trainer workshop on Wednesday November 10th 2010 (Expo Center 508)

The CIDOC “Train The Trainer” (TTT) programme is an initiative to equip museum professionals with the skills to deliver training about CIDOC materials to other museum professionals. It is intended that this will enable many more people to have access to the rich expertise that is encapsulated in CIDOC standards, guidelines and best practices recommendations.

Currently only a limited number of museum professionals are able to attend the CIDOC conference and the workshops, sessions and working group meetings that occur at them. This produces a bottleneck in the distribution of CIDOC materials. With more people able to deliver training at a local level, perhaps in their own institution or at a regional event, the number of people who will have access to CIDOC material will increase.

However, to deliver training one needs some additional skills. This one day workshop concentrates on helping museum professionals develop or hone their existing training skills so they can become a regional trainer. It includes information and training on designing as well as delivering material and helps prepare museums professionals for delivering a range of training on documentation topics.

Attendees may wish to couple this workshop with the CIDOC CRM tutorial on Sunday 7th of November to help them prepare for training local colleagues in the use of the CIDOC CRM in their institution or region.
